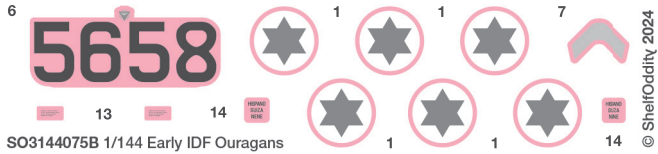

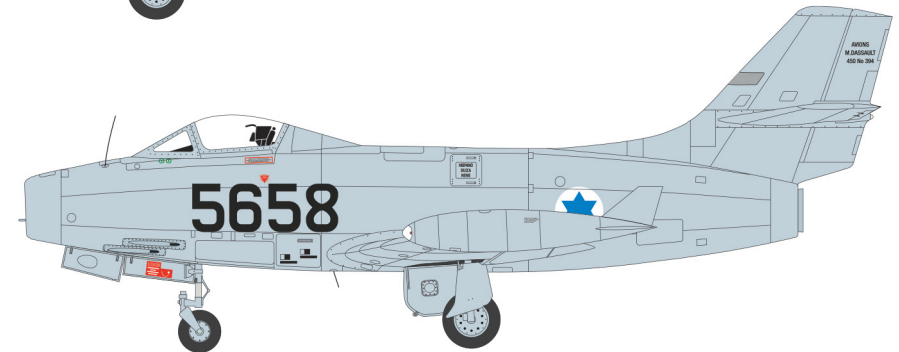
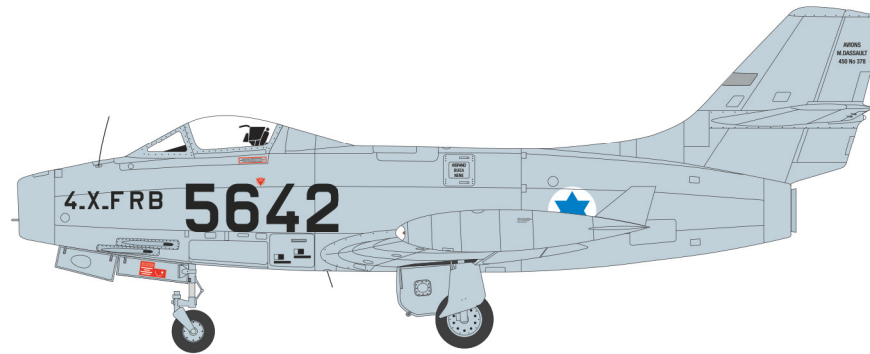

This decal set is recommended for Miniwing kits – both resin and plastic releases. Decals are made using silk print technology (BOA Bodecek Agency) and feature a limited amount of transparent base around the graphics.

This set depicts the earliest IDF livery used on Ouragans purchased from France in 1955.

To additionally enhance your model, a SO2144016 PE detail set can be used.

The machine is depicted when freshly delivered from France – that is why civilian registration is still present.

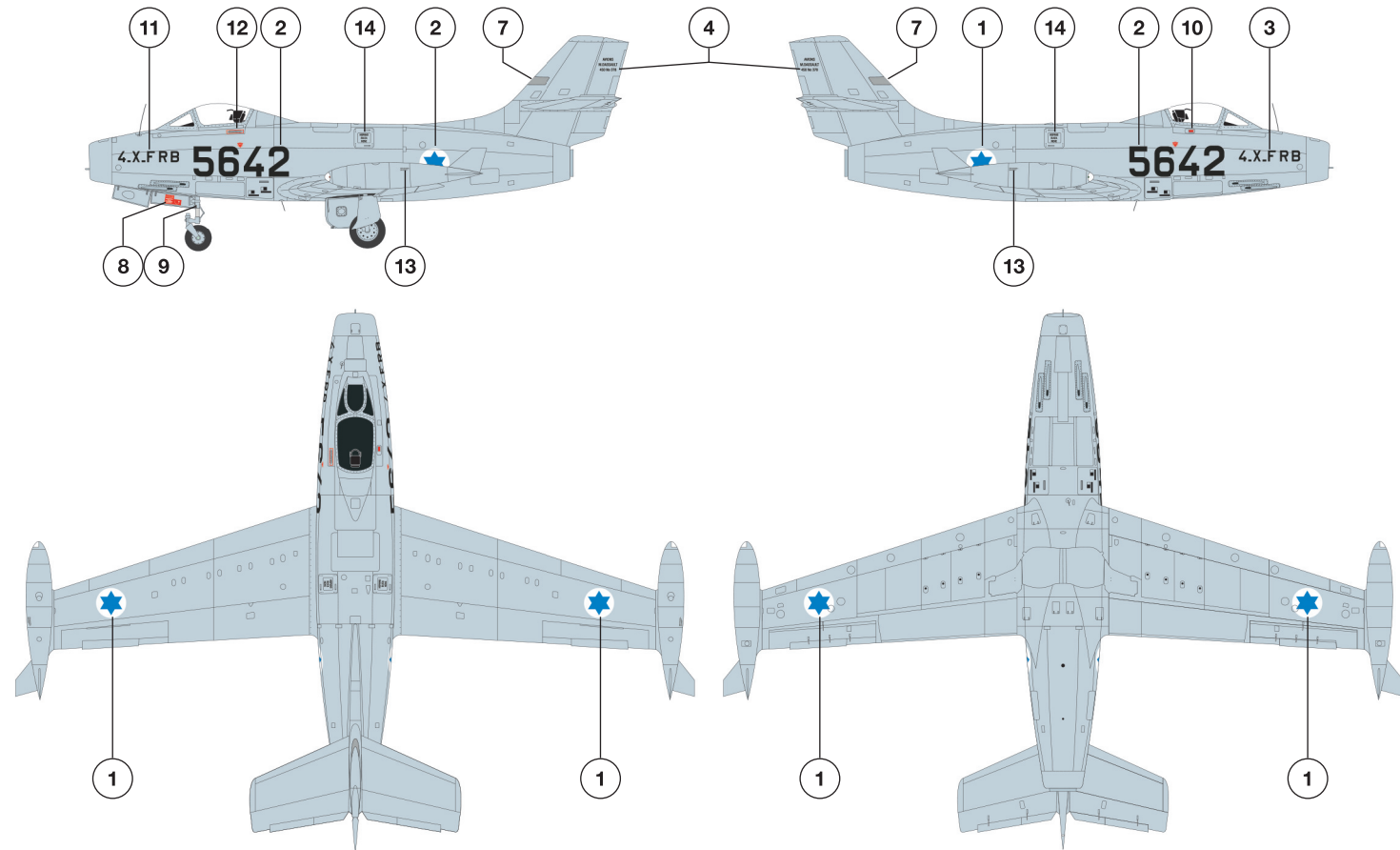
Natural metal finish, cockpit interior kept in black.

The inner surfaces of landing gear doors, gear legs as well as wheel hubs seem to be left in the natural metal finish.

The machine is shown here with wingtip tanks, as visible on the existing photos of this machine.

Later in 1956 the civilian reg. number has been removed and the remaining markings were unchanged for some time.

113 Squadron, Hatzor AFB, May 1956

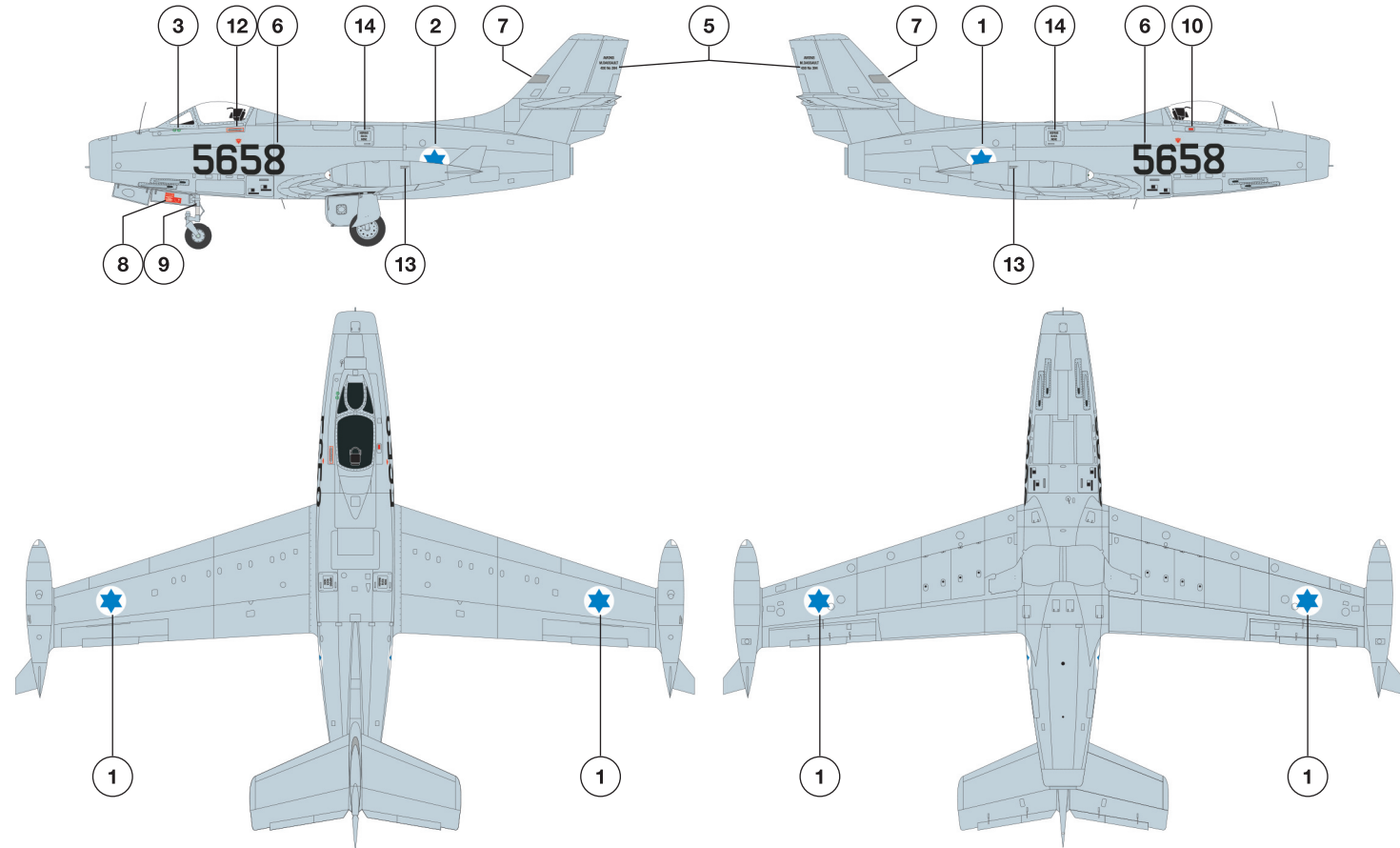
This is the machine in which Lt. David Kishon shot down an Egyptian plane over Nitsana making the first aerial victory of 113 Squadron. The reasons why two kill roundels were painted under cockpit are unknown.

Natural metal finish, cockpit interior kept in black.

The inner surfaces of landing gear doors, gear legs as well as wheel hubs seem to be left in the natural metal finish.

The machine is shown here with wingtip tanks, as visible on the existing photos of this and other machines from this squadron/period.
